

Tips for Music Presenters

- Get to know all the music available in the station library. Avoid getting into the habit of playing the same few CDs every day.
- Keep up-to-date with what is happening in the music world.
- Listen to other programmes and other stations, read the music press to keep up to date
- Know in advance how many ad breaks, news bulletins, weather and traffic reports will be in the programme and plan your music around them.
- Always plan for more music than you actually need, just in case of emergencies.
- Consider to create an structure for your programme, with different blocks, themes, special features, regular items. This would make it easier for you when planning each programme, and it is more entertaining for the listeners.
- Keep a record of the music you play, to avoid repetition, and to facilitate listeners that might call looking for specific information.
